Stockdell Manor Books (and other Art)

Active years 2018 to current

Fall 2025. Two art pieces in the book of the Hot Springs (AR) Poetry Festival.

Accepted to two exhibits at Art on Main in Dallas. June 2025, "Sunshine on A Spring," Found Metal Sculpture for the exhibit, "Letting the Light In." July 2025, "Grandma's Quilt," book for the exhibit, "Shelter."

In April, 2025, interviewed for the Modern Romantic podcast. Available as podcast or YouTube.

October 2024 and March 2025 attended Found Metal Art Sculpture welding class at Eureka Spring School of the Arts. Used welder and plasma cutter to create several works.

April 2024 two pieces of art were accepted into the Fenix Art Gallery exhibit called "Women's Work." Fayetteville. Also, accepted as a regular artist into the Fenix Art Gallery. Continuous submissions since then.

September 2024 planned to teach Celtic Knot Design at the Harp Gathering in North Carolina. (Canceled due to Hurricane.) Will be teaching Celtic Knot Design at the Harp Gathering in Ohio in May 2025.

A member of three online art communities with monthly projects: since 2021, Helen Heibert's The Paper Year an online paper arts and bookmakers' group; since 2022, Ali Manning's Vintage Page Design an online bookmakers' community; and since 2024 Nancy Dawes' Celtic knot group, Nancy's Knot Club.

January 2024 taught the Zentangle method of drawing to Helen Heibert's The Paper Year online bookmakers' community. This is a monthly subscription group with approximately 1,000 members.

Attendance at the Movable Book Society (MovableBookSociety.org) bi-annual conferences in 2018, 2021, and October 2023.

Artist in Residence at the Redbarn Studio in Lindsborg, Kansas, in November 2019. Two-week residency split between harp and bookwork. Taught a bookmaking class. A harp concert was planned but was canceled due to a blizzard. Open studio at the gallery to interact with visitors. Participated in a full-day community event of local galleries. Back at Redbarn in December 2023, displayed work and taught a bookmaking class at the Smoky Valley Arts & Folklife Center.

April 2023 became a Certified Zentangle Teacher (CZT) for the Zentangle method of drawing.

Taught beginner Zentangle classes in June and August 2023.

September - December 2023 had a show at the Fayetteville Public Library of my Zentangle work.

October 2023 participated in the Fayetteville Public Library's Maker's Faire. Taught Zentangle classes and gave harp concerts.

Front cover drawings on the *Folk Harp Journal* Summer 2023 and Summer 2024.

Designed (cover and book interiors) and edited two books for Dr. Loren Pankratz, *Patients Who Deceive*, released in November 2021, and *Modern Swindles* released in June 2022.

Repeated participation since 2018 in the monthly Instagram challenge #areyoubookenough. One submission was featured in a national speech given by the moderator about the book structure.

Submissions to the Miniature Book Society (MBS.org) annual competition in 2018 and 2019.

Active years 2003 to current (but limited since April 2023).

Will be teaching Sheet Music Layout and giving a concert at the Harp Gathering in Ohio in May 2025. 2013 and 2019 Taught music technology (iPad, apps, foot pedal, etc.) at Harp Gathering, a national harp conference in Ohio.

Wedding and special events harpist throughout the NW Arkansas region.
